

YAK RACK

TOOLS NEEDED

- Fasteners appropriate for your installation location (not included)
- Tools will vary, based on foundation structure and fasteners used

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS


1. Choose an installation location that is structurally sound, and locate wall studs (if applicable). Select fasteners appropriate for your mounting surface.

2. Space each YAK RACK according to the length of your kayak as well as what your wall will accommodate, and mark the holes with a level and/or square. Consider the height at which you want to store your kayak at this time as well.

3. If the fasteners you are using are larger than the factory holes, you will need to expand the factory holes with the appropriate drill bit.

4. If pilot holes are necessary for your fasteners, drill those at this time (even if pilot holes aren't required, we recommend them to keep the YAK RACK steady while mounting)

5. Fasten the YAK RACK to a sturdy foundation, using the appropriate fasteners and tools for the surface: i.e. lag bolts, carriage bolts, concrete bolts, etc.
